TO: ICS- 300 COURSE CANDIDATES:

To register, you must have completed the prerequisite courses, IS-100, IS-200. (If required, please obtain employer/supervisor approval prior to registration)

Target audience: Those individuals who may assume a supervisory role in expanding incidents where some or all of the Command and General Staff positions may be activated, as well as Division/Group Supervisor and/or Unit Leader level positions or multi-agency coordination system/emergency operations center (EOC) staff.

Course Objectives: Describe how NIMS Command and Management component support the management of expanding incidents. Describe the incident/event management process for supervisors and expanding incidents as prescribed by the Incident Command System (ICS). Implement the incident management process and develop an Incident Action Plan on a simulated incident.

The course is offered by Northampton Community College instructors who have extensive background in NFA, NIMS/ICS and ICS/EMS presentations. Class is limited to 36 students. Your prompt response will assure you a seat for this training. On February 15, 2010, the remaining seats will be released to PEMA for statewide broadcast.

The course is 24 hours, starting Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, 8:00 am - 4:30 pm, February 22, 23 and 24, 2010. All classes will be held in Room 042, Government Services Center, 601 Westtown Road, West Chester, Pa. 19380, ¼ mile west of the US 202 By-Pass Westtown Road exit.
